CONSEQUENCES OF DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR IN THE LIBRARY

At the discretion of the library staff, the following steps will be taken:

- 1. First Warning----The patron will be asked to stop the inappropriate behavior.
- 2. Second time-----The patron will be asked to leave the library for a 2-week period.
- 3. Third time-----The patron will be asked to leave the library premises and their library privileges will be suspended for 6 months.
- 4. Any subsequent time---The city police will be called, and all library privileges will be lost.

If a suspended patron would like privileges restored, he/she may file an appeal in writing with the Library Board of Trustees. Appeals will be considered at the next regular meeting of the Board, provided the appeal has been made 7 days prior to the regular meeting. The Board will consider if privileges are to be restored.

If behavior is deemed to be bad enough, steps 1-2-3 may be skipped, and go directly to step 4.
